Bridge City Chamber Of Commerce will award two \$1,000 scholarships to two Bridge City High School and two Orangefield High School graduating seniors who plan to attend college or vocational school full time in the fall of this year.

Applicant Guidelines

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen
- 2024 Graduating Senior
- Graduate plans to attend a two-year or four-year accredited college

What required documentation will I need to attach to the application?

- GPA
- Class Ranking
- Official Student transcript: High school transcript must be submitted in an envelope sealed by the school and must bear an original signature of a school official and/or an original school seal. Faxed copies are not considered official.
- Application form
- Detailed list of extracurricular activities, community involvement and volunteer work
- One-page essay explaining why it's important to support your community.
- Two one-page letters of recommendation (one from a school staff member and one from a community member)
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Procedures

- A selection committee will review applications.
- Scholarship checks will be made payable to the student, accredited college, university, or trade school once verification of enrollment as a full-time student is received. Proof of enrollment must be received by October 1st or the scholarship will be forfeited.

Instructions:

- Read all criteria and guidelines for the scholarship carefully to determine your eligibility to apply.
- All materials requested must be included in packet to be considered for scholarship.
- All applications do require student's signature and date.
- Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.
